The PopChips company in California began producing its all-natural chips in 2007, using a technique that employs heat, pressure and half the fat involved in making regular fried potato chips. Nutritionally, the PopChips original flavor posts better numbers than Sun Chips original in total calories and fat, even with six more chips per serving.



Other PopChips potato chip flavors include barbeque, salt and pepper, sea salt and vinegar, and Parmesan garlic, in one-ounce (\$1.50) and 3.25-ounce (\$2.99) bags. The company is
